A Devotion from Daniel

The status quo that most of us have been used to is that preachers and politics mix as well as oil and water. It has not always been like this in our nation's history. In the 18th and 19th centuries the pulpit was used to direct and to point people in a direction that would allow them to see clearly on which side of any particular issue God's will would fall upon. Of course, like most things men who desired power more than holiness abused their calling and twisted God's word to benefit themselves or those whom they personally supported. So now, preachers of all denominations have retreated from taking strong biblical positions on issues that have become deemed "political".

Now there are some who fear speaking God into politics out of fear of repercussion. Those who might fear losing tax exemption statuses or fear seeing their name put out into the world as someone who boldly stands behind God's word. A fear of protesters or online mockery keeps many from speaking out.

Others avoid "political" topics because they understand their calling is to be that of a messenger of Gospel not mouthpiece for any political organization. Basically, these folks understand that left or right, we all need the Gospel that is our number one priority. To support any candidate or party outwardly would cause (in a state like MI) 50% of my audience to tune me out. That to make a point I feel passionately about I would cause anyone to not hear the Gospel is unacceptable.

For me, I personally fall into this second category. The loss of tax exemption statuses will never cause me to not speak the truth. The fear of nasty phone calls or protestors will never keep me from speaking truth. I pray that the truth I speak will always be wrapped in the love of my savior, but if the words I speak (or write) scare the forces of evil enough to make my name famous so be it. If the words, that I type here or that I speak on YouTube weekly mean evil will line up against me so be it.

But you will never hear me endorse a candidate. You will never hear me ask you to vote for any man or woman... I have lived long enough now to know that in my 20+ years of participating in democracy that both the donkey and the elephant will often disappoint. Just like us they are flawed sinful creatures and I cannot in good conscience place my faith in any of them. This is not to say that there is not good and evil, right and wrong. I would hope that as we learn together, as we are drawn closer to Christ, we would be able to view our politics through a Jesus lens. Ask WWJD?

So, you won't hear me endorse any man or woman going into November's election, but I will also not be silent. I can't, I can't sit idly by. I won't endorse a candidate, but I will speak on the issues that God speaks on, and I will ask you to also speak and act upon these issues.

On November the 8th when you head to the polls... and you should. You may feel called to vote for Gov. Whitmer, you may feel obliged to vote for Tudor Dixon pray over that decision. We have all seen since the start of this pandemic the power a Governor has to help or hurt their home state. But you will vote your conscience on this decision, I will not tell you one of these women is "God's chosen". What I am going to ask you to do today is to show up on November the 8th and vote NO on Proposition 3. I ask you this directly, I come to you not privately but as a congregation because while the men and women we elect will often fail us, standing tall against evil never ever will. Below is the Proposition you will be asked to vote upon.

Below is the summary of the amendment that will appear on your election ballot:

Proposal 22-3

A proposal to amend the state constitution to establish new individual right to reproductive freedom, including right to make all decisions about pregnancy and abortion; allow state to regulate abortion in some cases; and forbid prosecution of individuals exercising established right

This proposed constitutional amendment would:

- *Establish new individual right to reproductive freedom, including right to make and carry out all decisions about pregnancy, such as prenatal care, childbirth, postpartum care, contraception, sterilization, abortion, miscarriage management, and infertility;*
- *Allow state to regulate abortion after fetal viability, but not prohibit if medically needed to protect a patient's life or physical or mental health;*
- *Forbid state discrimination in enforcement of this right; prohibit prosecution of an individual, or a person helping a pregnant individual, for exercising rights established by this amendment;*
- *Invalidate state laws conflicting with this amendment.*

Should this proposal be adopted?

Over 750,000 of our fellow Michiganders signed a petition to ensure that this ballot measure would appear. I want to be 100% frank with you. The taking of an innocent life is evil. The stopping of a human heart is a tragedy. Pagan people have always sacrificed the most innocent of their culture to appease false God's. This is not new. We no longer throw newborns into fires to appease volcanos, we now longer spill the blood of infants on alters to ensure a good harvest. Now we poison, crush and dismember children in the womb as we kill and sacrifice to the idol of vanity and self. VOTE NO ON PROP 3.

We cannot stop this everywhere, but we can do is take advantage of what **may be our last chance to stop it** here. Perhaps you are on the fence and perhaps you are unsure if your morals as a Christian should be enforced upon those who have different beliefs. Voting yes on prop 3 or abstaining from voting would cause Michigan to become one of the most extreme states in our union. Primarily because of the stipulation in the proposition that states "Invalidate state laws conflicting with this amendment". This means not only would the 90-year-old ban on abortion in this state be overturned but all other guidelines would be cast aside. This means:

- We would have **no** guidelines preventing late or full-term abortions
- Safety standards for abortion clinics could be erased
- Abortions could be performed by non-doctors
- Babies that survive attempted abortions would no longer be required to be cared for

- **Parental consent would no longer be required.**
 - **This means a minor victim of rape, statutory or otherwise could be taken in for an abortion by her assailant no questions asked.**
- Partial birth abortions would no longer be banned
- Taxpayer money could be spent on abortions
- **Public school employees could help minors acquire abortions again without parental consent.**
- No 24-hour waiting period

The list goes on sadly...

The powers of darkness have chosen a side, and they are organized and effective. They have already convinced three quarters of a million of your friends, family and neighbors to sign their petition. Large liberal states have begun advertising abortion vacations in states where restrictions stand. One female politician recently went on television and stated that fetal heartbeats are not even real they are just a construct of the male dominated medical community. The evil has even invaded Christ's Church as "progressives" try to disguise evil as compassion. In the Detroit News an editorial was recently penned by Rev. Bonnie A. Perry a Bishop in the Episcopal Diocese. The Reverend wrote "As a pastor, and as a person of deep faith and love for Jesus Christ, I believe that abortion should be safe, accessible, medically informed and rare." But why so many songs, and why THESE songs in particular? Well, this series of articles is going to attempt to answer those very questions as we explore some of the songs that make up our worship sets on Sunday morning.

I am so thankful that we serve a merciful God. Yes, He is a Sovereign God. Yes, He is a God who is awesome in power. Yes, He is a God whose standard we have broken. But, He is also a God who abounds in mercy and grace for us, His children. He has shown that over and over again. Think of the Ninevites, to whom He showed mercy. It's only fitting that we remember that measure of mercy in our worship of Him. The MCC Missions Team met 9/14/22 and decided unanimously to use contingency funds to provide "one time" extra support to Ninos de Mexico and Karamoja. The decision was based on immediate needs for these two missions we support. We agreed to provide funds for 2 students at Ninos (total: \$590). Each child will need three uniforms, tennis shoes, dress shoes, a backpack, and other school supplies. Also, we plan to provide \$500 toward the urgent food need in the Karamoja community. We are also reaching out to IDES to determine if they have, or can establish, a connection with any churches in Uganda, as that may be a more cost-effective means to provide food to those in need.

In addition to these outreach opportunities, Meadowbrook will be hosting a food packing event on Saturday, February 4th, 2023 from 8:00am-noon. The IDES organizers tell us that if we have at least 50 volunteers, we can pack the 15,000 meals in the time allocated that day.


Kids For Christ
